  - Start of 2023 budget discussions- Proposed to start budget and expenditures discussion in the Fall. Budget to be finalized and voted on in the March meeting.

## • Treasurer's Report: Debbie Milford

- Treasury report summary as of Aug 31, 2022:
  - The bank balance beginning January 1, 2022 was \$103,784.02. Deposits to date are \$3,720.00. This number is always low until September when Membership Drive begins. Expenses for 2022 to date are \$13882.45. The largest expense to date was for Lawn Maintenance. In addition, \$40,000.00 was transferred to a Savings Account. There were \$212.25 in deposits in transit from Toolkit. The

bank balance in the Checking Account as of Aug 31, 2022 was \$53409.32. The Savings Account earned \$9.60 in interest. The bank balance for the Savings Account as of Aug 31, 2022 was \$40009.60.

- 2023 Budget: All board members present their 2023 budget line item projections, to include spending wish list.- Tabled
- Membership: Jody and Les Terry, Gary Koblitz (Pawel's sub)
  - Jody and Les, 16 year residents of OHECA, took over the membership position. They began introducing themselves (via door knocking) to residents and approximately met with <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> of the neighborhood. Canvassing is predicted to have attracted new members.
  - We will pause discussing the membership budget until the Treasurer is present.
  - Postcards announcing membership drive have been mailed. In November another mailing will be sent.
  - Proposed purchasing 2 additional signs to advertise membership. Will be voted on at the next meeting.
  - Proposed to donate \$500 for advertising at each of 3 the local pools. Will be voted on at the next meeting.
